The work shall be performed in conjunction with the NYPA overall "crack repair program" of the Generator Rotor Spider Arms. Detailed scope of work shall be in accordance with the attached technical specification "Specification for Post Weld Heat Treatment of St. Lawrence-FDR Generator Rotor Spiders after Weld Repair", Dated March 3, 2017.

Bidders shall provide pricing for performing the work for a total of three units within a period of three years, starting with Unit 28 in July of 2017 followed by the second unit in 2018 and the third in 2019.
