### South Battery Park City Resiliency Project Design Services

#### Description of Goods or Services to Be Bid

Battery Park City Authority d/b/a Hugh L. Carey Battery Park City Authority ("BPCA") requests proposals (each individually, a "Proposal" or collectively, the "Proposals") from architecture and/or engineering firms (each individually, a "Proposer" or collectively, the "Proposers") to provide BPCA with multidisciplinary design services (the "Services") in support of its South Battery Park City Resiliency Plan (the "SBPC Plan").
